SEARCH FOR A HOUSE

After identifying, engaging and receiving sound advice from our partner bank on your eligibility, including the loan amount you can be granted based on your income/profile, it is now time to start a search for your home

Look for a house that falls within the amount that you have been prequalified for, and that meets the Bank's lending criteria. Check the property title (papers) through a formal search at the relevant land registry using the services of a Lawyer.



ASK FOR NMRC REFINANCING



Ask your bank if your mortgage loan qualifies for NMRC refinancing. Refinancing your mortgage loan will increase its tenor to as much as 20 years and also significantly reduce your expected monthly principal and interest repayments.





APPLY FOR A MORTGAGE

Having evaluated your finances, identified a home that you can afford and established that your loan could qualify for NMRC refinancing, it is now time to apply for a mortgage from our partner banks. Required documents may include copies of your tax returns, pay slips, bank and asset statements, ID and credit report.
